

St. Augustine High School Financial Aid Application Procedures

St. Augustine High School has a limited amount of funds available to assist families who demonstrate a financial need for tuition aid. Various programs are established for this purpose including work scholarships, general grants, Booster Club grants, Cor Unum grants, and Ryan Family grants to name a few.

Families who received financial aid during the 2007-2008 school year must reapply to be reconsidered for aid in the 2008-2009 year.

In order to determine the relative need of each family that applies, **all** applicants must complete the following forms by **March 31, 2008**.

1. Private School Aid Service (PSAS) evaluation form. The completed form and processing fee of \$20.00 must be submitted to PSAS by March 31, 2008. If you are also applying for aid for a student who will attend Our Lady of Peace, you can use one form for both schools. Be certain to check the "yes" box in section E for students at either St. Augustine or OLP that you wish to be considered for aid.
2. St. Augustine Supplemental data form. The complete form must be submitted to the school's financial office. (Note: Students attending the school for the first time in 2008-2009 must also submit the personal recommendation form.)
3. To be eligible for tuition aid students must maintain a quarterly GPA of at least 2.0 and maintain a citizenship level equal to the school's minimum standards for extra-curricular activities.

In addition to these forms, returning students wishing to apply for work scholarship grants, or Booster Club grants must complete separate forms for these programs and submit them to the school's financial office. Separate work scholarship applications may be picked up at the main office.

All necessary financial aid application forms are available through the school's main office.
