GLOBAL LEADERSHIP SUMMIT – Davos, Switzerland
“Education as a Human Right”

Often times, here in America, we take our education for granted. Too often we look at school as a chore or a burden. But the reality is that education is a blessing. More so, it is a human right. While we sometimes get frustrated, bored, or uninterested in our education, we need to take a step back and understand what is happening in other parts of the world. The sad truth is that in certain parts of the world, education is still – even in today’s 21st Century – being denied to some people because of their religion or the color of their skin. This issue runs even deeper and more severe when it comes to the educational rights of young girls. We know that education and knowledge equals power and opportunity. Just think about how much more love, peace, freedom, and innovation there would be in the world if everyone was given an equal right to a quality education.

If this sounds like something that interests you, or if you are simply interested in a unique global leadership opportunity, then SAHS and AOLP has some exciting news. We are proud to announce a very special and unique international travel program, June 19 – 29, 2015, to Amsterdam, Paris, Geneva, and Davos. Highlights of the trip include a visit to Anne Frank’s house, The Hague and the International Court of Justice, UNESCO (a branch of the UN that uses education to promote peace), the UN office in Geneva, and a two-day leadership summit with hundreds of international students in Davos. At the summit, students will hear from keynote speakers and participate in group activities. Students will work on creative solutions to challenges that face an ever-changing world driven by technology, globalization, and improved human rights. This is an incredible opportunity that will not only promise to be a lifetime memory, but it will also look great on a college application.

The price for this trip is \$5,470, plus some gratuities. This price is based on an enrollment of 20-24 students from both SAHS and AOLP. The price is subject to change. Should we get more than 24 students, the price will go down. The cost includes all transportation, all hotels, a full-time tour director, entrance into all of the sites mentioned above, and two meals per day. EF Tours offers a variety of payment options; pay in full at time of enrollment or pay a \$95 deposit and sign-up for the monthly flex-pay payment program.

This trip is currently being priced as a “private tour” for SAHS and AOLP students only. Although we will participate in the summit with hundreds of other students, we will travel from site to site as a “private tour.” Should our enrollment numbers fall short of expectations, the trip will change to an “open” trip and we would then be consolidated with students from another school. If this happens, the price will again be reduced. Therefore, the quoted price of \$5,470 should be viewed as a maximum price.

Because of the high-demand for this international leadership summit, the deadline to register is Oct. 15, 2014. Please see Mr. Linville if you have any questions.
