One of the great blessings of Saints is that families often discover that their connection to the school does not end at graduation. The friendships, traditions, and mission continue to unite generations of Saints families.

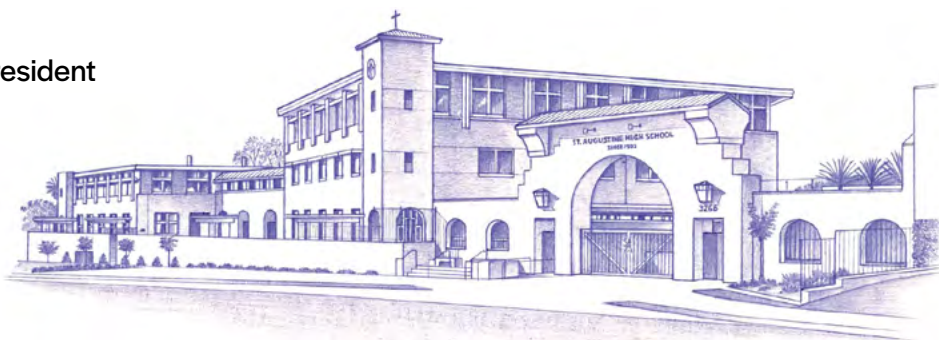
We warmly invite you to stay plugged in and continue walking with us as part of the broader Saints family. Your presence and involvement remain a valued gift to our community.

Enzo Simon, a current Junior at Saints, is a great example of such a student. Enzo has capitalized on his interest in the field of Medicine and Research; specifically about a field of research called Electrical Impedance Tomography (EIT). Electrical Impedance Tomography is a process that makes use of an electrical assessment device and an algorithm to measure the development of the lungs in premature infants. This new way to assess respiratory issues in premature infants is groundbreaking, non-invasive and critical info for NICU (Neonatal Intensive Care Unit) doctors and nurses.

In March we highlighted the medical scholarship of Saintsman Enzo Simon '27 as he was invited to give an oral presentation at the Western Medical Research Conference in Carmel, CA on the research he has been doing at UCSD.

Enzo presented to a room full of doctors, scientists, and researchers. He did an amazing job presenting and answering questions at the Q&A, and in typical Enzo fashion, brought levity and humor, even eliciting laughter from the audience. Over the course of the 3-day conference Enzo was busy attending talks, watching presentations, looking at the various posters, and simply mingling with the people.

Enzo submitted the same abstract to the California Association of Neonatologists, and was selected to present again in March 2026 ... this time in Coronado!

Most recently, May 2026, Enzo was invited to make a presentation at Rady's Children's at an event sponsored by the UC San Diego School of Medicine, dept. of Pediatrics.

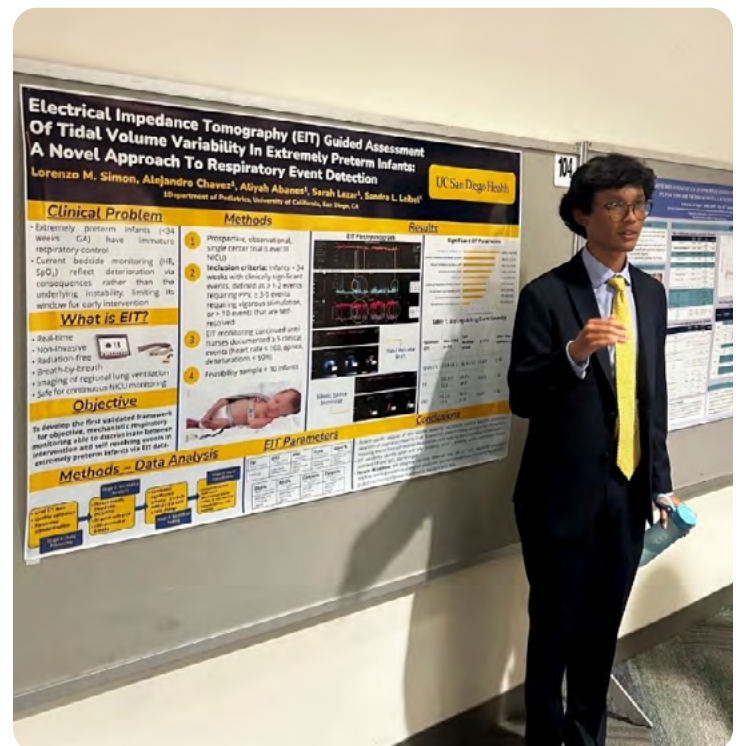

Enzo's Enterprise

Saintsman Enzo Simon is presenting research on Electrical Impedance Tomography, a non-invasive assessment tool that uses electrical monitoring and computer algorithms to measure lung development in premature infants.

The technology offers NICU doctors and nurses critical new information when evaluating respiratory problems in newborns. Enzo's work is gaining attention in the medical community for its potential to improve care for some of the hospital's most vulnerable patients.

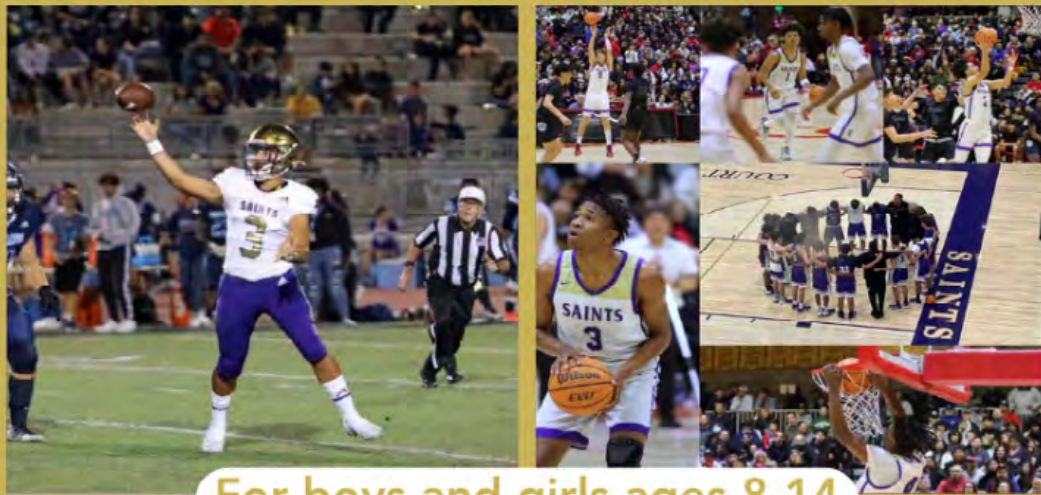
